It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

| 1  | SECTION 1. Chapter 21-28.6 of the General Laws entitled "The Edward O. Hawkins and                  |

| 4  | 21-28.6-19. Social equity and race analysis.  |
| 5  | (a) To facilitate greater equity in business ownership and employment in any business               |
| 6  | requiring a state license including, but not limited to, the cannabis market, the department of     |
| 7  | business regulation (the "department") shall undertake a social equity and race analysis (the       |
| 8  | "analysis"), which analysis shall be completed and the results thereof published on or before       |
| 9  | <u>January 1, 2021.</u>   |
| 10 | (b) The social equity and race analysis shall include:  |
| 11 | (1) A disparity study consisting of both qualitative and quantitative findings to determine         |
| 12 | whether racial disparities exist in the process to obtain a state license;                          |
| 13 | (2) To determine whether racial disparities exist in the process to obtain a license to             |
| 14 | engage in business relative to the cannabis market, a disparity study on whether racial disparities |
| 15 | exist in the arrest and conviction rates for possession of marijuana by determining percentage      |
| 16 | figures for such arrests and convictions aggregated by the following ethnic groups:                 |
| 17 | (i) African-American/Black;   |

| (c) The department shall consider, identify, and address the following factors for and              |
| gregated by each group identified in subsection (b)(2) of this section:                             |
| (1) Representation in the general population;   |
| (2) Rates of employment and unemployment;   |
| (3) Poverty rates; and  |
| (4) Arrests for or related to marijuana.  |
| (d) The analysis shall compile data as provided for by this section for the calendar years          |
| 009 through 2019, inclusive, and shall promulgate findings and conclusions relative to racial       |
| sparities and whether racial disparities exist in the process of obtaining a state business license |
| d to the existence of disparities in arrests and convictions relative to marijuana and shall        |
| entify any ethnic group that has been disproportionately impacted by marijuana prohibition.         |
| (e) All state and municipal agencies shall cooperate with the department to effectuate the          |
| urposes of the analysis.  |
| (f) On or before January 1, 2021, the department shall publish such findings and                    |
| nclusions and submit a copy of the analysis to the governor, the speaker of the house, and the      |
| esident of the senate.  |
| SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.   |
