It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 39-21-4 of the General Laws in Chapter 39-21 entitled "E-911

Uniform Emergency Telephone System Division" is hereby amended to read as follows:

#### 39-21-4. Advisory commission.

(a) There shall be an E-911 uniform emergency telephone system advisory commission consisting of fourteen (14) sixteen (16) members to be appointed in the following manner: five (5) members shall be the director of the department of health or his or her designee, the fire marshal or his or her designee, the colonel of the Rhode Island state police or his or her designee, the state telecommunications director or his or her designee, and the administrator of the division of public utilities and carriers or his or her designee; the minority leader of the house of representatives or his or her designee; the minority leader of the senate or his or her designee; three (3) members shall be appointed by the speaker of the house: one of whom shall be a member of the house of representatives, and one of whom shall be a representative of the police chiefs' association, and one of whom shall be a representative of the telecommunication services provided that is the primary provider to the E 9-1-1 PSAP; three (3) members shall be appointed by the president of the senate; one of whom shall be a member of the senate, one of whom shall be representative of the fire chiefs' association, one of whom shall be a representative of the wireless telecommunication industry; and three (3) members shall be appointed by the governor: two (2) of whom shall be representatives of the public, one of whom shall be representative of the Rhode Island league of cities and towns.
