It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 31-22-9 of the General Laws in Chapter 31-22 entitled

"Miscellaneous Rules" is hereby amended to read as follows:

31-22-9. Throwing debris on highway -- Snow removal.

- 4 (a) No person shall throw or deposit <u>or cause to be blown onto</u> upon any highway <u>or</u>
- 5 <u>roadway</u> any glass bottle, glass, nails, tacks, wire, cans, <u>grass/grass clippings</u> or any other substance
- 6 likely to injure any person, animal, or vehicle <u>or cause a hazard</u> upon the highway <u>or roadway</u>, or
- 7 likely to deface the beauty or cleanliness of the highway or roadway, nor shall any person in
- 8 removing snow from any driveway, public or private, leave the snow in any condition so as to
- 9 constitute a hazard on the highway or roadway.
- 10 (b) The director of transportation shall post signs advising the public of penalties for
- 11 throwing debris on the highways <u>or roadways</u>.
- 12 (c) Violations of this section are subject to fines enumerated in § 31-41.1-4.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
