2 hereby amended by adding thereto the following section: 3 5-22-1.2. Live entertainment -- Town of Bristol. 4 The town council of the town of Bristol is authorized to license, regulate, or prohibit "live 5 entertainment" in the town of Bristol, including, but not limited to, live performances of music or sound by individuals, bands, musicians, disc jockeys, dancing, or karaoke, with or without 6 charge, provided that "incidental entertainment" be permitted as of right, and no license shall be 7 required. "Incidental entertainment" means background music provided at a restaurant, bar, 8 9 nightclub, supper club, or similar establishment, limited to the following format: 10 (1) Live music performance limited to no more than a maximum of three (3) acoustic 11 instruments that shall not be amplified by any means, electronic or otherwise; or 12 (2) Prerecorded music or streamed music played over a permanently installed sound 13 system. If a bar or restaurant includes incidental entertainment, it cannot charge a cover charge; 14 shall not allow dancing by patrons of the establishment; cannot employ flashing, laser, or strobe 15 lights; and the maximum volume, irrespective of the format, is limited solely to the boundaries of the premises at all times, and shall permit audible conversation among patrons of the 16
