It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 4-19 of the General Laws entitled "Animal Care" is hereby 2 amended by adding thereto the following section: 3 4-19-11.4. Use of animals in medical training. (a) An educational program training individuals in the medical treatment of human beings 4 5 shall not use a live animal in the education or training of students, residents, or physicians if: 6 (1) At least one other accredited training program in the state in the same medical 7 discipline does not use live animals; or 8 (2) There is an alternate teaching method that teaches the medical procedure or lesson 9 without the use of an animal. 10 (b) Any person who violates the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be fined not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000) for 11 12 each animal used. 13 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
