HOUSE RESOLUTION

SUPPORTING PROVISIONS FOR REQUIRING ESSENTIAL CAREGIVERS FOR RESIDENTS OF NURSING HOMES AND LONG-TERM CARE FACILITIES DURING HEALTH DISASTER EMERGENCIES

1 WHEREAS, Throughout the COVID-19 public health emergency, many of our nation's 2 most vulnerable people, and their loved ones, lived under the constant fear that getting COVID-3 19 could lead to severe complications that could permanently lead to lifelong health ailments or to death; and 4 5 WHEREAS, Fear of COVID-19 was even more pronounced for our loved ones residing in skilled nursing facilities, intermediate care facilities for the intellectually disabled, and 6 7 inpatient rehabilitation facilities who were unable to have access to their essential caregivers during the pandemic health emergency. This painful and horrendous isolation had an incredibly 8 9 negative impact on the physical and mental well-being of all patients living in these facilities; and WHEREAS, The mental, emotional, and physical health and well-being of Rhode 10 Island's vulnerable residents of nursing homes and other congregate care facilities is of utmost 11 12 concern to the people of Rhode Island; and 13 WHEREAS, In 2021, the Rhode Island House of Representatives unanimously passed an 14 Essential Caregiver bill requiring rules and regulations to provide for the designation of essential 15 caregivers to provide in-person physical or emotional support to a resident of a nursing home or long-term care facility during the period of fifteen days after the declaration of disaster 16 17 emergency and until sixty (60) days after the termination of the declaration of disaster 18 emergency; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That this House of Representatives of the State of Rhode Island hereby

- 1 supports provisions requiring essential caregivers for residents of nursing homes and long-term
- 2 care facilities during health disaster emergencies; and be it further
- 3 RESOLVED, That the Secretary of State be and hereby is authorized and directed to
- 4 transmit a duly certified copy of this resolution to Nicole Alexander-Scott, MD, Director of the
- 5 Rhode Island Department of Health.

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
