It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 40-8 of the General Laws entitled "Medical Assistance" is hereby
- 2 amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 **40-8-33. Managed care hospital rates for obstetrician delivery.**
- 4 <u>To ensure better birth experience and postpartum care for Medicaid members, the executive</u>
- 5 office of health and human services shall implement an increase for hospitals providing birth and
- 6 <u>postpartum care in the following ways:</u>
- 7 (1) Set managed care payment rates for obstetrician delivery cases to one hundred ten
- 8 percent (110%) of the Medicaid fee for service (FFS) rate;
- 9 (2) Require that managed care payment rates in subsequent years be no less than one
- 10 hundred ten percent (110%) of the 2021 Medicaid fee for service (FFS) rate; and
- 11 (3) Require policies that permit doulas as defined in § 27-18-87 as part of the care team.
- 12 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

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EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

RELATING TO HUMAN SERVICES -- MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

1 This act would increase managed care hospital rates for obstetrician deliveries at one 2 hundred ten percent (110%) of the Medicaid fee for service (FFS) rate. The rates in subsequent 3 years would be no less than one hundred ten percent (110%) of the 2021 Medicaid fee for service 4 (FFS) rate. The act would also require policies that permit doulas as part of the care team. 5 This act would take effect upon passage.

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
