It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 12-5 of the General Laws entitled "Search Warrants" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

3 <u>12-5-11. Audio and video recording of private property prohibited.</u>

4 (a) It shall be unlawful for any law enforcement officer or peace officer as defined in § 12-

5 7-21, to place on the private property of another, any audio or video recording device(s) to capture,

6 generate, preserve, transmit or otherwise document the activities on that person's property without

their consent or without a valid search warrant issued by a neutral and detached magistrate or judge

8 upon a finding of probable cause.

9 (b) Any audio or video evidence generated in violation of subsection (a) of this section

shall be inadmissible in any criminal or civil proceeding filed against the property owner and/or

11 their tenants or guests.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
