Prohibition of rental application fees. 4 (a) A landlord, lessor, sub-lessor, real estate broker, property management company, or designee shall not require or demand any prospective tenant or tenant to pay a rental application 5 fee, or collect any rental application fee from a prospective tenant or tenant. 6 7 (b) For the purposes of this section, "rental application fee" means any monetary fee that 8 is collected during the rental application rental process for a residential unit, including, but not 9 limited to, a fee for a credit check, background check, screening, or administrative services. 10 (c) Any violation of this section shall be deemed a deceptive trade practice pursuant to § 6-13.1-2 and shall be punishable pursuant to the provisions set forth in § 6-13.1-14. 11 12 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
