It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 5-34 of the General Laws entitled "Nurses" is hereby amended by
- 2 adding thereto the following section:

### 5-34-50. APRN restrictive covenants void.

- 4 (a) Any contract or agreement that creates or establishes the terms of a partnership,
- 5 employment, or any other form of professional relationship with an advanced practice registered
- 6 nurse ("APRN") licensed to practice pursuant to § 5-34-45 that includes any restriction of the right
- 7 of the APRN to practice shall be void and unenforceable with respect to said restriction; provided,
- 8 however, that nothing herein shall render void or unenforceable the remaining provisions of any
- 9 <u>such contract or agreement.</u>
- 10 (b) Restrictions rendered void under subsection (a) of this section shall include, but shall
- 11 not be limited to the following:
- 12 (1) The right to practice in any geographic area for any period of time after the termination
- 13 of the partnership, or professional relationship;
- 14 (2) The right of an APRN to provide treatment, advise, consult with or establish a
- 15 professional relationship with any current patient of the employer; and
- 16 (3) The right of an APRN to solicit or seek to establish a professional relationship with any
- 17 <u>current patient of the employer.</u>
- 18 (c) Notwithstanding the foregoing, the prohibition on advanced practice registered nurse
- 19 covenants shall not apply in connection with the purchase and sale of a practice; provided the

- restrictive covenant and non-compete covenant is for a period of time of not more than five (5) 1
- 2 years.

## BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

1 This act would prohibit any agreement whereby an advanced practice registered nurse is 2 restricted in the right to practice in a certain geographic area, assist or provide treatment or establish 3 a professional relationship with any other employer; and establish the right of the advanced practice 4 registered nurse to solicit or seek to apply with the purchase and sale of a practice which includes 5 a restriction or non-compete clause within five (5) years. 6 This act would take effect upon passage.
