It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 45-19-16.1 of the General Laws in Chapter 45-19 entitled "Relief of Injured and Deceased Fire Fighters and Police Officers" is hereby amended to read as follows:

45-19-16.1. Presumption for heart disease and hypertension.

- (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, any firefighter or police officer, as defined in § 45-19-1, who is unable to perform the duties required thereof because of an impairment of health caused by heart disease, stroke, or hypertension is presumed to have suffered an in-the-line-of duty injury/disability, unless the contrary can be proven
- 8 by clear and convincing evidence; and the firefighter <u>or police officer</u> shall be entitled to all benefits
- 9 provided for in chapters 19, 21, 21.2, and 21.3 of this title.
- 10 (b) This presumption shall not apply to firefighters <u>or police officers</u> hired after July 1,

 11 <u>2023</u> <u>2025</u>, in the following situations:
 - (1) If a physical examination was conducted at the time the firefighter <u>or police officer</u> was hired and the examination revealed that person was suffering from heart disease or hypertension.
- 14 (2) If the firefighter <u>or police officer</u> had regularly or habitually used tobacco products 15 during the five (5) years prior to any diagnosis of heart disease or hypertension or suffering a stroke.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

1	This act would add police officers to fire fighters who are unable to perform their duties as
2	a result of heart disease, stroke or hypertension, to be presumed to have suffered an in-the-line-of-
3	duty disability, unless the police officer was hired after July 1, 2025, and there is clear and
4	convincing evidence that the police officer suffered the condition at the time of hire or regularly
5	used tobacco products for the five (5) years prior to a diagnosis.
6	This act would take effect upon passage.
