Use of state-owned/operated printing facilities. 9 Any state agency, state institution of higher education, and quasi-public agency which engages in the printing of more than fifty (50) copies of a contract, publication, brochure, mail 10 piece, notice, and/or promotional material shall, when practicable, use an existing state-11 owned/operated print shop/facility as long as said state-owned/operated print shop/facility is 12 capable of processing and manufacturing the aforementioned materials. 13 14 SECTION 2.
