It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 42-143-1 of the General Laws in Chapter 42-143 entitled "Science
2 and Technology Advisory Council" as enacted by Chapter 281 of the 2006 Public Laws is hereby
3 repealed:

4 ~~§ 42-143-1. Council established. [As enacted by P.L. 2006, ch. 281.]~~

5 ~~There is hereby created a Rhode Island science and technology advisory council to consist~~
6 ~~of thirteen (13) members: three (3) of whom shall be appointed by the governor, with two (2) of~~
7 ~~those so appointed to be designated by the governor as co chairs; six (6) of whom shall be the~~
8 ~~members of the science and technology advisory council, as established by executive order 05-07;~~
9 ~~one of whom shall be appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives; one of whom shall~~
10 ~~be appointed by the house majority leader; and one of whom shall be appointed by the president of~~
11 ~~the senate; and one of whom shall be appointed by the senate majority leader. The membership of~~
12 ~~said council shall receive no compensation for their services. The council shall support the state's~~
13 ~~research institutions, promote entrepreneurial development, enable all organizations to become~~
14 ~~more innovative, and perform any other advisory functions as the legislature may designate.~~

15 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
