It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 22-6-15 of the General Laws in Chapter 22-6 entitled "Committees  
2 and Staff" is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 **22-6-15. Annual appropriations.**

4 The general assembly shall annually appropriate a sum that shall be necessary to carry out  
5 the provisions of §§ 22-6-10 — 22-6-14 [and § 22-6-16](#).

6 SECTION 2. Chapter 22-6 of the General Laws entitled "Committees and Staff" is hereby  
7 amended by adding thereto the following section:

8 **22-6-16. Nonprofit funding transparency.**

9 [Any nonprofit entity, as a condition to requesting state grants or funding from the general](#)  
10 [assembly, shall submit to the general assembly and post on their website, a complete and detailed](#)  
11 [list consisting of the ten \(10\) highest paid director, officer and employee salaries, costs, benefits](#)  
12 [including, but not limited to, health insurance and rental cars, and any and all forms of](#)  
13 [compensation provided to those individuals in the organization. Any other sources of funding,](#)  
14 [including fundraising, endowments, trusts, memorial giving and/or any and all activities that fund](#)  
15 [the nonprofit entity shall also be included in the disclosure.](#)

16 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon passage.

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

1           This act would require any nonprofit, as a condition for requesting state funds from the  
2 general assembly, to submit and to post on their website, a detailed list of ten of their highest paid  
3 director, officer and employee salaries, and any forms of compensation provided to those  
4 individuals. It would further require the disclosure to include fundraising, endowments, trusts,  
5 memorial giving and/or any and all activities that fund the nonprofit.

6           This act would take effect upon passage.
