RELATING TO FOOD AND DRUGS -- THE GOOD SAMARITAN OVERDOSE
PREVENTION ACT OF 2016

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 21-28.9 of the General Laws entitled "The Good Samaritan Overdose
2 Prevention Act of 2016" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
3 **21-28.9-6. Training to administer opioid antagonists.**
4 All lifeguards, and park and forest rangers, employed to work at any state or municipal
5 public beach or facility on a full-time basis shall be trained in the administration of opioid
6 antagonists, pursuant to the provisions of this chapter. All state or municipal public beaches and
7 facilities, that employ lifeguards, and park and forest rangers, shall maintain and provide a
8 minimum of four (4) doses of the opioid antagonist.
9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

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EXPLANATION
BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
OF

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- 1 This act would require all lifeguards, and park and forest rangers, who work on a full-time
2 basis at any public beach or facility to be trained in administering opioid antagonists. The act would
3 also require all state and municipal public beaches or facilities, that employ lifeguards, and park
4 and forest rangers to keep available a minimum of four doses of opioid antagonist.
- 5 This act would take effect upon passage.

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
