RELATING TO MOTOR AND OTHER VEHICLES -- MOTOR VEHICLE OFFENSES

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 31-27 of the General Laws entitled "Motor Vehicle Offenses" is

2 hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

3 **31-27-26. Prompt violation payment.**

4 Any motorist who receives a moving violation, which may be paid without a court

5 appearance, and who pays the fine in full within thirty (30) days of its issuance, shall not have the

6 violation recorded on the motorist's division of motor vehicle's driving record; provided, however,

7 that this procedure may not be utilized more than twice a year.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION
BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

A N A C T

RELATING TO MOTOR AND OTHER VEHICLES -- MOTOR VEHICLE OFFENSES

- 1 This act would prohibit the division of motor vehicles from recording a moving violation
- 2 on a motorist's driving record, if the moving violation is one that can be paid by mail and is paid,
- 3 in full, by the motorist within thirty (30) days of its issuance; provided that, this procedure cannot
- 4 be utilized more than twice in one year.
- 5 This act would take effect upon passage.
