It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 12-7-10 of the General Laws in Chapter 12-7 entitled "Arrest" is
- 2 hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 <u>12-7-10. Resisting legal or illegal arrest</u> Resisting legal or illegal arrest by peace
- 4 officer-Resisting directive of correctional officer.
- 5 (a)(1) It shall be unlawful for any person to use force or any weapon in resisting a legal or
- 6 an illegal arrest by a peace officer, if the person has reasonable ground to believe that he or she is
- 7 being arrested and that the arrest is being made by a peace officer.
- 8 (2) It shall be unlawful for any person in custody of the Rhode Island department of
- 9 corrections to use any force or weapon to resist a lawful request or directive by a corrections officer.
- 10 (b) Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be punished by a fine of not
- 11 more than five hundred dollars (\$500) or by imprisonment for not more than one year, or by both
- 12 fine and imprisonment.
- 13 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

RELATING TO CRIMINAL PROCEDURE -- ARREST

- 1 This act would make it unlawful for a person in the custody of the department of corrections
- 2 to use any force or weapon to resist a lawful request or directive.
- 3 This act would take effect upon passage.
